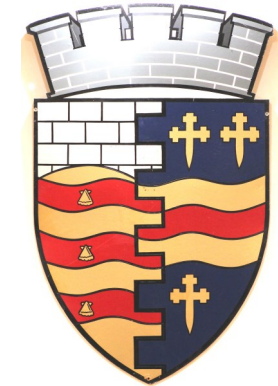

SAE required for postal applications.

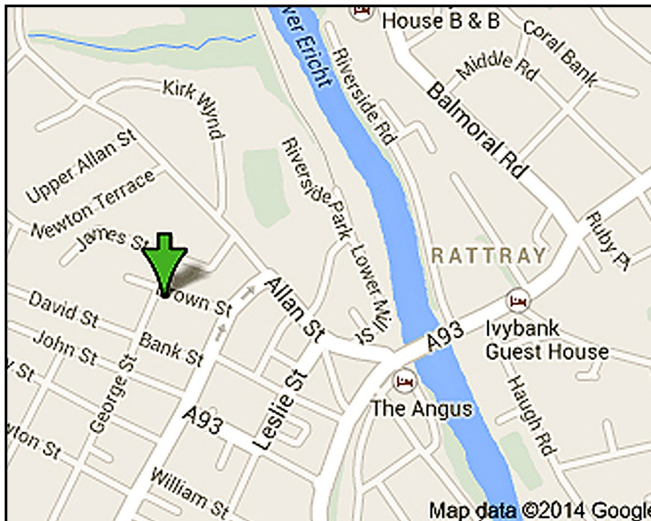
Closing date for applications is 13<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
